Step by step instructions:

Settings>Siri&Search:

Here you'll find the settings to turn Siri on. Some of the settings that I find important are the Siri suggestions category.

You'll want to customize these to your needs. I find that having them all on is the best way to ensure you are accessing Siri from all paths.

Settings>Accessibility>Siri

Here you can allow a current app to remain visible while Siri is active and allow Siri to listen for "Hey Siri" when your phone is covered or face down.

You'll want to Google instructions on setting up shortcuts or find step-by-step instructions in our Shortcuts group, to allow third-party shortcuts from outside the Apple gallery.

Settings>Shortcuts>Allow Untrusted Shortcuts

Here, I'll give you a tip. We have a shortcut when scanner is triggered with a receipt, it automates an email with said receipt attached to quickbooks account expenses category and it shows up in quickbooks online with the merchant name and the amount of the purchase.

Hey Siri, party time/business time

When you add a new accessory, the Home app will suggest useful ways for it to run automatically. You can do things like enable your porch lights to turn on each evening, open the garage door as you arrive home, and more.

A new visual status at the top of the Home app gives you a summary of accessories that require your attention, have important status changes to share, or can be quickly controlled.
